1.) Lot Addition Woodland Avenue – Krista Peterson

2.) Short – Term Rental Ordinance Discussion

The planning Commission has the following observations/recommendations for the Wellsboro Borough Council:

- Clarity is needed in the process for revoking of Short Term Rental use and what is considered to be a violation.
- There needs to be a specific process for handling complaints, especially those that do not merit calling 911. Such as, littering, parking issues and noise.
- Ordinance should state that the property owner must be present at the home during time of rental.
- In section 14.22.2.13 Emergency Information it should be stated that property managers only pertains to pre-existing permit short-term rentals.
